Quayside MediaCityUK required a strong reporting structure to supplement existing data and better awareness of accessible options before tendering for recycling and waste services

THE SOLUTION

As the UK's only independent benchmark standard for waste facility services our review was the obvious choice to take on Quayside MediaCityUK's complex challenges

THE RESULT

- ✓ A recommendation to introduce dry mixed recycling as a new recycling stream thereby increasing engagement with the circular economy
- ✓ Data analysis proved that some exemplary average disposal rates were achieved during the period examined
- ✓ Suggested ways to improve tenant engagement with food waste as a key method of reducing costs, carbon footprint and increasing recycling
- ✓ Opportunity to change the cardboard management system and improve performance
- ✓ The process identified that there is a potential to reduce the current spend by 21% through alternative solutions or rebates
